SPECIAL TROPHIES AND PRIZES:

Grampian Television Offshore Sailing Cup for best East Coast of Scotland yacht: ALOUETTE

Offshore Navigation Shield for best yacht whose owner/skipper have not taken part previously in the North Sea Yacht Race: LUNA (from Denmark)

A new, one-off trophy, a tiny quaich for the Youngest Competitor, which went to Jon Arild, a 6 month old "baby" boy onboard MIGHTY DUCK

The Karmøy Cup was awarded to Johannes Markhus on ANSUMI of Karmøy - Johannes has taken part in the race many years previously as is keen to promote the race again in the Karmoy area.

A new trophy was awarded to ALOUETTE for the Best Start (ie. first yacht across the start line).

Munro Plant Sales Cup for the best family yacht: LILLE BLA (the skipper's daughter had been nagging her father for 2 years to do the race & finally they did it, with the daughter onboard, and they were 2nd boat arriving at Macduff and 4th overall)

Oil Challenge Cup (instead of the Hawk Trophy) was awarded to the crew who have shown a true sense of adventure: LEX LUTHER - which was crewed by a team of young lads lead by Trygve Wiig. The happy crew were last seen surrounded by female admirers at the prize-giving dance.

Overall Winner: VELA skippered by Odd Olsen of Stord, veteran and many times race winner. Also onboard Vela was Kim Adams of Macduff who has been instrumental in revitalising the race and shore-side activities.

Various other prizes were donated by Seilas Magazine and five local hotels (Knowes Hotel, Banff Springs Hotel, Fife Lodge Hotel, St. Brandon House Country Cottages & Seafield Hotel in Cullen) donated weekend breaks as prizes.
